I also loved the 2017 Syrah Eddie's Patch, which has more of a Côte Rôtie vibe in its spring flowers, black raspberries, and dried earth-like aromas and flavors. Coming from pure volcanic soils and brought up 40% new oak, it's medium to full-bodied, has lots of tannins, terrific fruit, and a seamless texture.

A ripe, lightly spicy and a very well-mannered Syrah that, while full in body and built upon a fine tannic foundation, is at once very deep and wonderfully refined at the same time.
